This way you can decide on your own to sign up for the Sundays you want to serve and to see which jobs are still open, making it possible to sign up right there.

Did you know that we need at least 15 people to perform different tasks at each service? We will have some volunteers on that day to help explain the jobs. We have such great opportunities here at Trinity for each one of us, not only to worship together, but also to participate and build together by being a part of this Trinity family!!

Christian Food Pantry

DECEMBER REPORT: Volunteers were busy serving 249 families which provided food for 573 people in December. More than 85 turkeys or hams were offered along with other Christmas meal items to appreciative clients who had signed up ahead of time. The turkeys were purchased with the help of Aldi gift cards from the Valparaiso FOP. Both Strack and Van Til stores were generous with helpful donations of food bags purchased by shoppers at their stores. Numerous other groups gave generously which helped supply the basic and extra needs of pantry families. The New Year will be ‘back to basics’ for the regular food items offered to clients needing pantry-type assistance. Items that are often over-looked when donations are considered are saltine crackers, egg noodles, peanut butter, juices, bathroom tissue, pork ‘n’ beans, and canned fruit. Looking ahead: In February, bean soup kits are offered with money donations used to help buy the onions, Jiffy corn bread mixes, and ham hocks given with the kits. But as always – any food donations are gladly received and served. A special ‘thank you’ goes out to many ‘extra’ volunteers who pick up food items regularly from Strack and Van Till, Aldi’s, VHS, and the 7 sponsoring churches.

Adult Forum

January 7: Adult Forum begins the new year with a DVD titled, “Weaving a Global Neighborhood,” narrated by Rick Steves, the well-known travel host and guidebook author. Rick and an ELCA missionary, Kevin Jacobson, take us on a journey to Papua New Guinea. There were two goals in making the video: (1) to highlight the Lutheran program of matching church districts – like sister cities – between developed and developing countries, and (2) to help Christians learn to think and act globally in the context of “Love one another.”

Papua New Guinea is a diverse country about the size of Arizona with over 800 tribal languages. In Papua, people know each other intimately. In the morning a villager can step out of his house and identify who walked by during the night by the footprints in the sand. There is a oneness with nature as well as each other. Their architecture consists of homes with poles for studs, woven walls, thatched roofs, and dirt floors.

Come to see how Rick Steves and missionary Kevin Jacobson join with the people of New Guinea in ceremonial activities and daily living, such as a meal of chicken, yams, carrots and bananas wrapped up in leaves and buried in hot rocks. Everyone is welcome to come to Adult Forum for this informative program.

January 14: Come to Adult Forum on January 14th to meet and talk with our most recent new members. This will be an opportunity for them to tell a little bit about themselves so that we can get to know them better. At the same time, those attending will be introduced so that the new members can also learn about them as well. Everyone is encouraged to come to this important welcoming of our new members at Adult Forum.

Food Pantry Items for January

For January, Trinity members are asked to meet a Christian Food Pantry need by donating coffee and laundry detergent. Any size ground coffee or instant coffee, either regular or decaffeinated, will be helpful. Of course, donations of any kind, cash or food items, are always appreciated.

Trinity is one of seven churches supporting The Christian Food Pantry housed at the Asbury Center of First Methodist Church across the street from our location. The pantry continues to supplement families by providing food staples to those who are in need right here in our community. Thank to members of Trinity who have continually supported the independently run food pantry in our neighborhood.

BACKGROUND CHECK POLICY: TLCV is committed to providing a safe church environment. In October, the Church Council approved the Background Check Policy submitted by the Safety Team. This policy requires background checks to be performed on all volunteers who participate in TLCV programs and activities related to youth and family ministries, health ministry, or Stephen Ministry. If you are presently involved in one of these ministries, we ask you to verify with your team leader that you are current with your background check. Background check screening is required every 3 years. If you only fill in or act as a substitute, you are still required to follow this policy. If you have any questions, please contact any member of the safety team or the Church Council. Background check forms are available from Betty in the church office and can be returned to her after completion.

Member Pledges Continue to Support Trinity: Not Too Late to Pledge for 2018

Once again this year, many Trinity givers have chosen to pledge their time, talents, and financial resources to Trinity Lutheran Church, our faithful worship and our missions. Regular weekly financial pledges help the congregation to plan and afford our yearly expenses. Regular giving affords the opportunity to faithfully commit to doing God's work each and every week.

Pledges can be made at any time by picking up a pledge card in the church office or at the welcome center in the foyer. Completed cards can be placed in the offering plates during services or delivered to the church office. Trinity offers a Simply Giving direct deposit option, a "Give" button on the Trinity home page, and a stock giving program. Pastor Tim can provide more information to interested members.

As of December 20, 2017, seventy-five (75) giving units have returned pledges for 2018. The total amount of these pledges is \$220,940. The total amount of all pledges (83) for 2017 equaled \$224,227. Several giving units that pledged in 2017 have not yet pledged for 2018. If these units pledge the same amount they did in 2017, the total pledge amount for 2018 would increase significantly. Thank you to all who have made commitments to Trinity's ministries.
