FINANCE COMMITTEE NEWS

End of November fiscal status

We are pleased to report that our income has increased considerably over the last few months. Our year to date income vs. expense deficit has improved from our high of \$20,000 to our present position of slightly over \$5,000. We have seen our cash position improve from its low point of \$2,000 to our present position of \$16,500. We are pleased to see that our parishioners are taking advantage of the nontypical methods of giving to the Church. In the last month alone, donations were received from a will and through a stock transfer. We have also seen an upswing in electronic giving. If we continue on this pace through the month of December, we believe we will be able to overcome our present deficit and close the year with a balanced budget of income equaling expenses. Let us give thanks and praise to the Lord.

Notes from the Minister of Music

There are two events that I would like to highlight before the Advent season:

The **STEM Woodwind Ensemble** from VU joins us at Trinity this Sunday, December 3 at the 8:00 AM service. This is a student run musical ensemble at Valparaiso University. Their mission as an ensemble is to promote the crossover between music and STEM (Sciences, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) fields, as well as to provide beautiful music. They seek to encourage middle and high school students to continue their musical passions into college. They are hoping to begin to raise some money for their spring tour to churches and schools. We will have a free will offering this Sunday to support the funds for their Spring STEM Tour. They will also stay after the first service and have a short presentation to the Sunday school children. It should be fun!!

Our church is going to host a concert on February 16, 2018 and we need host families for the students! The **Jenny Lind Vocal Ensemble** from Augustana College, Rock Island, IL is coming to Valparaiso on Friday, February 16, 2018. This is an advanced women's choir, 60-voice plus their choir directors, Professor Michael Zemek & Professor Sonja Hurty. I think this is a great opportunity to invite people to come to our church and share the music with the community!

Cold/Flu Season Reminders

To protect everyone, especially the youngest and oldest among us and those with chronic illnesses, please do not attend church functions if you are ill. In general, remember the simple ways to help prevent the spread of common contagious infections.

- Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with tissues, then wash/sanitize your hands
- Use an alternative "passing of the peace" by nodding, crossing your arms across your chest, or hand waving a peace sign
- Before serving and/or receiving communion wash/sanitize your hands
- If concerned, avoid the common cup during communion (or skip communion)

Church Council News – Background Check Policy

TLCV is committed to providing a safe church environment. In October, the Church Council approved the Background Check Policy submitted by the Safety Team. This policy requires background checks to be performed on all volunteers who participate in TLCV programs and activities related to youth and family ministries, health ministry, or Stephen Ministry. If you are presently involved in one of these ministries, we ask you to verify with your team leader that you are current with your background check. Background check screening is required every 3 years. If you only fill in or act as a substitute, you are still required to follow this policy. If you have any questions, please contact any member of the safety team or the Church Council. Background check forms are available from Betty in the church office and can be returned to her after completion.

Thrivent Members Can Help Out

Are you a Thrivent member and a Trinity member? If so, Trinity could use your help. Depending upon your Thrivent membership status, you may be eligible to apply for one or two Thrivent grants each year. These \$250 grants can be used for many Trinity relatactivities for both church needs and outreach.

The grants allow various Trinity groups to fund their events and activities. We have used Thrivent grants to help supplement the cost of running our Gifts of Hope program, feeding our homeless guests, and offering our in-house yoga program. Other grant ideas are being planned by various groups including health ministry, hospitality and faith-in-action/social ministry.

If you are willing to apply for a Thrivent grant, you can call the church office (462-9624) or stop in Monday through Friday and leave your name with Betty. On the weekend at church, you can talk to Pat Hellmers, Larry Baas, or Mike Delliquadri. Help will be available for the application process.
