Thrivent Members Can Help Out

Are you a Thrivent member and a Trinity member? If so, Trinity could use your help. Depending upon your Thrivent membership status, you may be eligible to apply for one or two Thrivent grants each year. These \$250 grants can be used for many Trinity related activities for both church needs and outreach.

The grants allow various Trinity groups to fund their events and activities. We have used Thrivent grants to help supplement the cost of running our Gifts of Hope program, feeding our homeless guests, and offering our in-house yoga program. Other grant ideas are being planned by various groups including health ministry, hospitality and faith-in-action/social ministry.

Choir Fest: Our church choir will be joined by First Christian Church, St. Paul Catholic Church and Liberty Bible Church for a "Choir Fest." The music festival will be hosted at First Christian Church here in Valparaiso on Sunday, November 12th at 4:00 PM. The church is located at 1507 Glendale Blvd., Valparaiso, IN. Luther's hymn for October 22: Hymn # 411 "We All Believe In One True God," can be found during the offering and in the postlude at the second service. This ancient medieval hymn, dating from the 14th century, is based on the Nicene Creed. Martin Luther used the first two lines of the German hymn and expanded it to three verses. If you read closely, you can see how he paraphrased the three articles of the creed. The hymn is in Dorian mode and is not an easy chant to learn right away but it has a nice flow. I'm sure that we can learn it in the future. The setting in the offering is by J. S. Bach and the setting in the postlude is by Jacob Weber.

Ways to give at Trinity Lutheran Church of Valparaiso (TLCV)

We cannot stress enough the importance of sharing of time and talents in our congregation, but this commentary is intended only to address the financial giving choices at our church. Currently the following options are available:

1. Placing donations in the collection plate (*using envelopes or not*)
 - Cash
 - Check
2. Simply Giving
 - Fill out "Simply Giving Form" located in the foyer and return to the Church office, designate amount and choose reoccurring giving or one-time gift.
 - Funds will automatically be transferred from your checking account into the Church's account.
3. Electronic giving
 - Access our website at: <http://tlcvalpo.com/>
 - Scroll down the home page to find the "donate" button. Clicking here will take you to a secure page for simple registration.
 - You may give via credit/debit card, checking, or savings account. You may give as a one-time donation, or may schedule regular reoccurring contributions.
 - The amount will be charged to your card or transferred from your account and electronically deposited into the Church's account.
4. Stock transfer
 - TLCV has an online trading account that will accept electronic transfer of stock ownership. This enables individuals to donate the value of the stocks without cashing them in. (this saves the capital gains tax, and permits you to claim the full amount as a charitable contribution)
5. Remembering the Church in your will
 - You do not have to be a millionaire to have a will. In fact, everyone should have one. Most individuals leave everything to their family, but is not TLCV also part of your family. When the time is right and you start your estate planning, we ask that you keep us in mind.
6. Other possibilities
 - Naming TLCV as beneficiary on your life insurance policy.
 - Transferring ownership of land or real estate.

Christian Food Pantry September Report

Families served in September: 214 - providing food for 458 people. Generally food donations have been VERY low but the pantry monies have been sufficient - for now - to buy items needed for basic giving. Along with the list of items regularly requested a few different things are needed for the Thanksgiving dinner 'menu.' Green beans, cream of mushroom soup, and small cans of French fried onions make up the green bean casserole needs. Chicken broth helps to make gravy or flavor the mashed potatoes. Canned sweet potatoes are often forgotten for donating. It has been a surprise that Jell-O has not arrived in any sacks lately. That with canned fruit make a nice Thanksgiving salad. A few pie kits will be offered which need evaporated milk, Jiffy pie crust mix, and pumpkin. Strack pies or cakes will also be offered for a dessert choice.

Thank you to all those that participated in the Grub Run/Walk October 21 with all proceeds going to the Christian Food Pantry. As always, through the last 35 years the pantry depends on donations from our sponsoring congregations to assist in serving the families in our 'neighborhood' needing pantry help.
